

RESOLUTION 2017-H

OF THE CLARK COUNTY-SPRINGFIELD TRANSPORTATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE TO ADOPT THE 2017 ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE ANALYSIS

WHEREAS, the Clark County-Springfield Transportation Coordinating Committee (CCSTCC) is designated the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Springfield urbanized area in Clark County by the Governor of the State of Ohio, acting through the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), and in cooperation with locally elected officials in the area pursuant to Agreement of Cooperation #18823 between ODOT and the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, CCSTCC has the authority and responsibility for the direction, coordination, and administration of the area-wide urban transportation planning process in accordance with 23 USC 134 and 49 USC 5303 and as described in the CCSTCC Prospectus dated November 2015; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 12898 mandates that CCSTCC, as a designated MPO, must develop a strategy that identifies and addresses disproportionately high and adverse human health or environmental effects of program, policies, and activities on minority and low-income populations; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 CCSTCC Environmental Justice Analysis describes the methodology used to identify minority and low-income populations and the methodology used to ensure that Environmental Justice is considered in all plans, policies, and activities.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the members of the Clark County-Springfield Transportation Coordinating Committee hereby adopt the 2017 Environmental Justice Analysis.
