WHEREAS, the Clark County-Springfield Transportation Coordinating Committee (TCC) is designated the metropolitan planning organization for area-wide transportation planning in Clark County by the Governor of the State of Ohio in accordance with the regulations of the United States Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the TCC is responsible for maintaining the area's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), in cooperation with local governments, transportation providers, and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT); and

WHEREAS, the city of Springfield has determined that the traffic signal located at the intersection of Pleasant Street and Wittenberg Avenue needs to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the project is part of the TCC's 2007 Roadway Safety Workplan and was reviewed accordingly by TCC staff and submitted to ODOT for funding consideration; and

WHEREAS, the signal replacement project has been awarded Federal funding utilizing Highway Safety Improvement Program funds in an amount not to exceed \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the project is consistent with the 2030 Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the next scheduled update of the biennial Transportation Improvement Program is not until SFY2010.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the members of the Clark County-Springfield Transportation Coordinating Committee approve the amendment to the FY2008-FY2011 Transportation Improvement Program as shown on the reverse side of this resolution.

THE FY2008-FY2011 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Clark County-Springfield Transportation Coordinating Committee (TCC) is designated the metropolitan planning organization for area-wide transportation planning in Clark County by the Governor of the State of Ohio in accordance with the regulations of the United States Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the TCC is responsible for maintaining the area's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), in cooperation with local governments, transportation providers, and the Ohio Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Engineer's Office has requested a modification to the funding for PID 78664, CLA-Medway Lighting Ph. 2, which is a street lighting enhancement project on Lower Valley Pike with a sale date in FY 2009; and

WHEREAS, the project is eligible for Federal Transportation Enhancements funding for Preliminary Engineering in FY 2008 in the amount of \$16,000 Federal (80%) and \$4,000 local (20%); and

WHEREAS, the TIP remains fiscally constrained with the addition of funding for the project; and

WHEREAS, the project is consistent with the 2030 Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the next scheduled update of the biennial Transportation Improvement Program is not until SFY2010.
