## **2040 Long Range Transportation Plan - Executive Summary**

### **Purpose and Need**

The purpose of this document is to update the 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan dated May 2008. The Long Range Transportation Plan is the statement of the direction that the region will be taking in transportation investment over the next 20+ years. The Long Range Transportation Plan is one of three core planning documents required of MPO's by the Federal government.

### **Transportation Goal**

The 2040 Transportation Plan Goal remains unchanged from the 2030 Transportation Plan. The Goal is to *"Restore, maintain, develop, and operate an inclusive multi-modal transportation system with sensitivity to land use relationships."*

### **Transportation Issues**

Transportation Issues for the region are described in detail on pages 18-31. This discussion includes congestion, highways, transit, pedestrian access and bikeways, scenic byways, rideshare, aviation, railroad and freight, multi-modal transportation, and environmental mitigation.

### **Air Quality**

Air Quality is discussed on pages 31-37. The Air Quality Conformity Determination Technical Memorandum is a separate, stand alone appendix, however a summary is provided beginning on page 32.

### **Financial Forecast/Fiscal Constraint**

Financial forecasting is discussed on pages 38-42. Staff prepared the financial forecast with the cooperation of ODOT Central Office, utilizing historical data to support future Federal and State funding estimates. The total projected funding throughout the life of the plan is \$969,040,135.

### **Public Participation/Consultation and Cooperation**

Public and agency review and participation is discussed on pages 43-44. Staff coordinated four public involvement open houses, and received two comments. No comments were received from Federal, State, or local consultation agencies.

### **Transportation Projects**

Added guardrail to the scope of the inventory. Changed the budget to \$75,000.

#### **Surveillance – 605.1**

Clarified that crash data compilation activities are not focused solely on “hot spots.”

#### **Air Quality Advocacy Program – 665.1**

Combined the Air Quality Advisory Program and Rideshare programs into one work element. Removed the FY14 program proposal from end product list.
