SR235/SR41 Roundabout

Matt Parrill reported that as a part of project development, ODOT is required to do public involvement and the presentation today would be given at the public involvement meeting on January 29th at the Pike Township Fire Dept. Matt introduced Craig Eley, Traffic Engineer with ODOT District 7 who gave the presentation on the proposal of a roundabout at SR235 and SR41, as well as purpose and need for the project and benefits of a roundabout. Lowell McGlothin asked where this current concept is being used. Craig state that there are currently no roundabouts with high speed approaches in Ohio yet, but there are two in Ohio where it is 55 mph on two approaches and 45 mph on the other two approaches. Craig added that there are a lot of lower speed roundabouts in Ohio. Lowell also asked if there would be speed signs placed before approaching the roundabout. Craig stated that there would be advisory signs as you approach as well as signs to lower your speed. Leo Shanayda asked where the intersection ranks as far as crashes in the state. Craig stated that the intersection is not listed on the Highway Safety List, but showed up as a High Risk Rural Road. Ron Macaluso asked what the width of the roundabout would be. Craig stated that the width of the traffic lane and circle would be wide enough to accommodate a large vehicle, such as a combine. He added that there would be a truck apron included for those larger vehicles.
