#### **MINUTES**

Motion by John Burr, seconded by Howard Kitko to approve the minutes from the March 10, 2017 meeting.

#### **FINANCIAL REPORTING**

#### **Budget Status & Cash on Hand Report**

Motion by Lowell McGlothin, seconded by Matt Parrill to approve the Budget Status & Cash on Hand Report for March 2017. Richard Henry noted that the cash balance is currently higher than it was this time last year and asked if there was a danger of running out of money. Scott Schmid stated that a balance has been carried forward for quite a few years and at this point the TCC is catching up to old budget.

Scott Schmid stated that a stakeholder meeting was held within the last week and currently they are working on finalizing the economic development. There will be more public involvement this summer. #### **Blanket Requests**

Motion by Lowell McGlothin, seconded by Matt Parrill to issue three new Blanket Certificates: \$4,000 for Travel, \$10,000 for Audit Expenses, and \$5,000 for Other Expenses.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT**

#### **Prior Approval Requests**

Motion by Richard Henry, seconded by Lowell McGlothin to approve the Prior Approval Request for three TCC staff to attend the 2017 Mid America Association of Transportation Officials (MAASTO) in Cleveland on July 25-27, 2017. Amount is not to exceed \$2,400.00 and includes registration, hotel, meals, vehicle rental/fuel, and parking. Vote: Motion approved

#### Other

- TCC Annual Meeting: Scott Schmid reported that the Annual Meeting is scheduled for Friday, August 11<sup>th</sup>. There was discussion regarding possible locations for this year, whether to remain at Clark State or a new location (Hollenbeck, Heritage Center, CTC or The Dome). Members stated the location, room size, and parking has worked well with Clark State. There was further discussion regarding hosting the meeting at The Dome. Scott stated staff could work with staff at The Dome and Clark State can be the fall back option if plans don't work out. Members were still agreeable to the catering option and the \$15 cost per person.
- LUCRPC Planning: Scott reported that the LUC Coordination Agreement went before Clark County Commission on May 10<sup>th</sup> and was approved. TCC will begin planning related work with Logan and Champaign Counties on July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- MPO Coordination and Reform Rule Repeal: Scott reported that a Senate and House have both approved to repeal the rule and is now awaiting signature from the President.

#### **FY2018 Planning Work Program**

Scott Schmid presented Resolution 2017-E for TCC approval. This resolution is for the adoption of the FY2018 Planning Work Program. Scott highlighted any changes made based on minor comments received from ODOT since the draft document was presented at the March meeting. Scott stated hard copies will be mailed to those TCC members/alternates not in attendance at the meeting. An electronic copy has been posted to the TCC website and additional hard copies are available upon request. Motion by Howard Kitko, seconded by Matt Parrill to approve Resolution 2017-E. Vote: Motion approved

#### **FY2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program**

Scott Schmid presented Resolution 2017-F for TCC approval. This resolution is for the adoption of the FY2018-FY2021 TIP document. Scott briefly reviewed comments received during the public involvement period in April and any changes that were made since the draft document was presented at the March meeting. Hard copies will be mailed out to all TCC members and an electronic copy has been posted to the TCC website. #### **Certification of the Planning Process**

Scott Schmid presented Resolution 2017-G for TCC approval. This is a self-certification resolution stating that the TCC is conducting the Transportation Planning Process in accordance with all applicable regulations and is in conjunction with the TIP. Motion by Leann Castillo, seconded by Karen Duncan to approve Resolution 2017-G. Vote: Motion approved

#### **2017 Environmental Justice Analysis**

Scott Schmid presented Resolution 2017-H for TCC approval. This resolution is for the adoption of the 2017 Environmental Justice Analysis. Scott stated that Environmental Justice is the 1994 Executive Order by President Clinton which directs Federal agencies to identify and address disproportionally high and adverse effects of their actions on minority and low-income populations. The updated document, which was last updated in 2006, includes population mapping, benefits and impacts, and public outreach. Scott stated the draft document was available for public comment during the TIP open houses in April and was available online for public comment for 45 days. There were no comments received. An electronic copy has been posted to the TCC website and additional hard copies are available upon request. Motion by John Burr, seconded by Lowell McGlothin to approve Resolution 2017-H. Vote: Motion approved

#### 2017 Title VI Program

Scott Schmid presented Resolution 2017-I for TCC approval. This resolution is for the adoption of the 2017 Title VI Program document and certifies that the TCC does not discriminate against anyone within the Federal Highway Title VI Program Coverage area which includes disability, low income, Limited English Proficiency, age, sex, national origin, color, and race. The Title VI document establishes process and procedure for proper handling of any Title VI complaints received by the TCC and addresses non-discrimination provisions in DBE program and consultant contracts. Scott briefly reviewed any changes from the last document which was adopted in September 2014. Scott stated the draft document was available for public comment along with Environmental Justice Analysis document during the TIP open houses in April and was available online for public comment for 45 days. There were no comments received. An electronic copy has been posted to the TCC website and additional hard copies are available upon request. Motion by Lowell McGlothin, seconded by John Burr to approve Resolution 2017-I. Vote: Motion approved

The following are items for discussion and action during the June 9, 2017 Transportation Coordinating Committee meeting.

#### FY 2018 Planning Work Program Amendment #1

Resolution 2017-J (attached) is a proposed amendment to the FY 2018 Planning Work Program. The amendment corrects a typographical error on the budget chart on page 34. The CMAQ Total Direct Expenses figure was incorrectly calculated at \$37,928.89 in the PWP approved May 12. The amendment reflects the correct calculation \$40,428.89. This typographical error of \$2,500 changes the grand total budget figure to \$1,063,637.70.

Staff requests discussion and approval of Resolution 2017-J by voice vote.

#### FY2018-2021 TIP Amendment

Resolution 2017-K (attached) is a proposed amendment to the FY2018-2021 TIP to carry forward project phases that were included in the previous TIP. The projects affected are on the chart attached to the resolution.

The amendment also moves TCC STP controlled funding from the Yellow Springs Street resurfacing project to the Belmont Avenue Phase 2 reconstruction project. The Yellow Springs project will remain programmed but will be reclassified as uncommitted funding. Through this move and by carrying forward funding while moving the FY17 phases forward, the new TIP retains fiscal constraint.
